For the efsli General Assembly on Friday the 12th of September 2014 and for the conference on the 13th and 14th of September 2014, we are looking for Flemish Sign Language interpreters (VGT), French Belgian Sign Language (*Langue des signes de Belgique francophone*) and for International Sign Interpreters working from English. ### **Flemish Sign Language Interpreters (VGT)**

For the conference the 13th and 14th of September 2014, we are looking for Flemish Sign Language interpreters. Interpreters who will work between English and VGT, VGT and English. Interpreters will receive 900 Euros (taxes included) for their interpreting services at the conference (1.5 days); travel expenses (up to 150 Euros), hotel and meals will be paid.

Prerequisites: Relevant training, experience in the conference topic and experience in international conference interpreting between English and VGT, VGT and English.

### **French Belgian Sign Language interpreters (LSBF)**

For the conference the 13th and 14th of September 2014, we are looking for French Belgian Sign Language (LSFB) interpreters who will work between English and LSFB and between LSBF and English. Interpreters will receive 900 Euros (taxes included) for their interpreting services at the conference (1.5 days); travel expenses (up to 150 Euros), hotel and meals will be paid.

Prerequisites: Relevant training or experience in international conference interpreting and conference topic and preferably ABILS (*Association belge des interprètes en langue des signes*) membership.

### **International Sign interpreters**

We are looking for experienced teams of interpreters to work between English and International Sign. One team will work a full day at the AGM on 12th September 2014, and all teams will work one and a half days during the conference on 13th and 14th September 2014. Interpreters will receive 1350 Euros (taxes included) for their interpreting services at the AGM & conference (2.5 days); travel expenses (up to 250 Euros), hotel (3 nights) and meals will be paid. Interpreters working during the conference (1.5 days) will receive 900 Euros (taxes included); travel expenses (up to 250 Euros), hotel (2 nights) and meals will be paid.

Prerequisites: Relevant training or experience in international conference interpreting and conference topic.

  - conference coordinator of an event related to sign language interpreting - colleague with whom you have worked with at a conference
  - Deaf consumer who has witnessed your conference work
