What's up Doc? Interpreting in the medical, mental and allied health care settings

For sign language using deaf people access to health care is complicated by the language barrier. This begins when making an initial appointment through to the health consultation, be that with a nurse, a general practitioner or medical specialist (consultant, psychiatrist, dentist, etc.). From the creation of the administrative file to the request of reimbursement (depending on the health care system) , from reading the prescription to a stay in a rehabilitation center; the presence of a sign language interpreter (SLI) is often essential.
